

Parade Lap Rules

These rules and procedures are in place to assure the safety of all drivers during both the staging and on-track driving portion of the Parade Lap. All drivers/passengers will be required to sign a waiver which states they have read and agree to comply with the rules listed herein when they check in for the Parade Lap. A smooth, fun and SAFE experience is what we want for each participant. Please READ and FOLLOW the rules below.

- 1. All drivers and passengers must wear a seat belt.
- 2. All electronic driver assistance systems within the vehicle must remain on while driving on the race course.
- 3. There will be absolutely no passing by any driver during the Parade Lap. The order in which you start your ride will be the same order in which you finish.
- 4. Pace Cars will be positioned at the front and rear of each group to monitor all drivers for compliance with the rules.
- 5. Reckless driving such as swerving, passing, excessive speeding, burnouts and all other stunts are strictly prohibited.
- 6. Any lagging/stopping to create space between yourself and other drivers so that you can then attempt to speed through a corner is not allowed.
- 7. This is not a race! All participants will ride a constant speed set by the Pace Cars in the front and rear of each group. Speeds will never exceed 70MPH at any time.
- 8. One direction only. Do not stop on track, unless it is for a mechanical problem.
- 9. Stay on course at all times. Do not drive into run-off areas, or over the curbing.
- 10. You are liable for any damage to the track, yourself and other participants. Please be cautious and be mindful of those around you.
- 11. In order to make the Parade Lap safe for all, participating in the Parade Lap while under the influence of DRUGS/ALCOHOL is absolutely prohibited. DPS officers will be monitoring each participant and will not hesitate to issue citations or arrest those violating this policy. If you have any doubt whatsoever about your sobriety please do yourself and all other riders a favor and do not attempt to participate in the ride.

Anyone in violation of any of the above safety guidelines will be removed from the track immediately and escorted off property. Any damage done to the track will be charged to the participant. This includes any oil or other fluid clean up.

We want to reiterate that we want all of you to enjoy yourselves. To make this happen, we must work together and use common sense while following these simple safety rules. Doing so will allow everyone to truly experience the track in a way it was meant to be. Thank you in advance for your cooperation!
